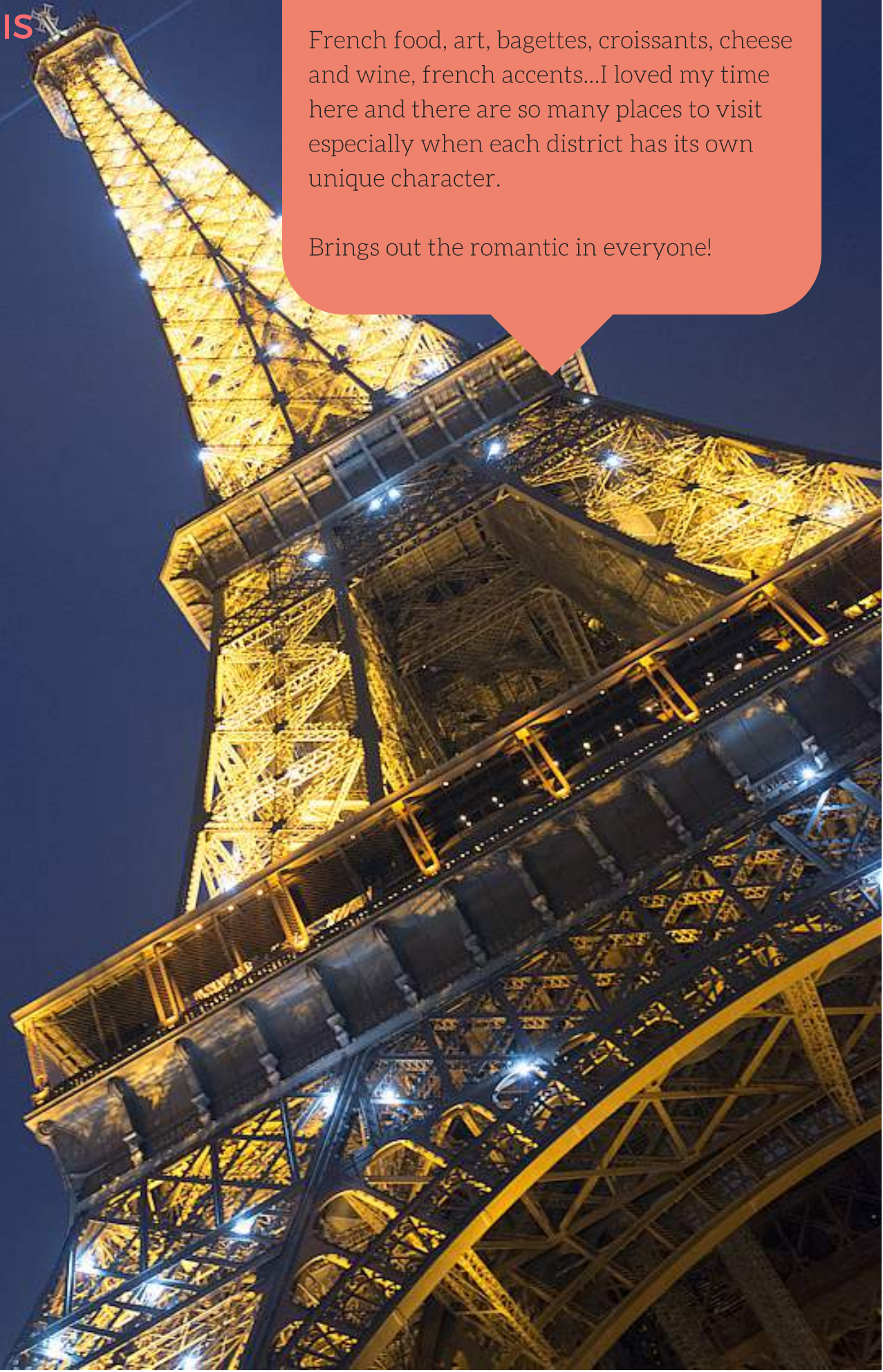
No 2

The food, particularly the seafood is amazing. You'll love it here!



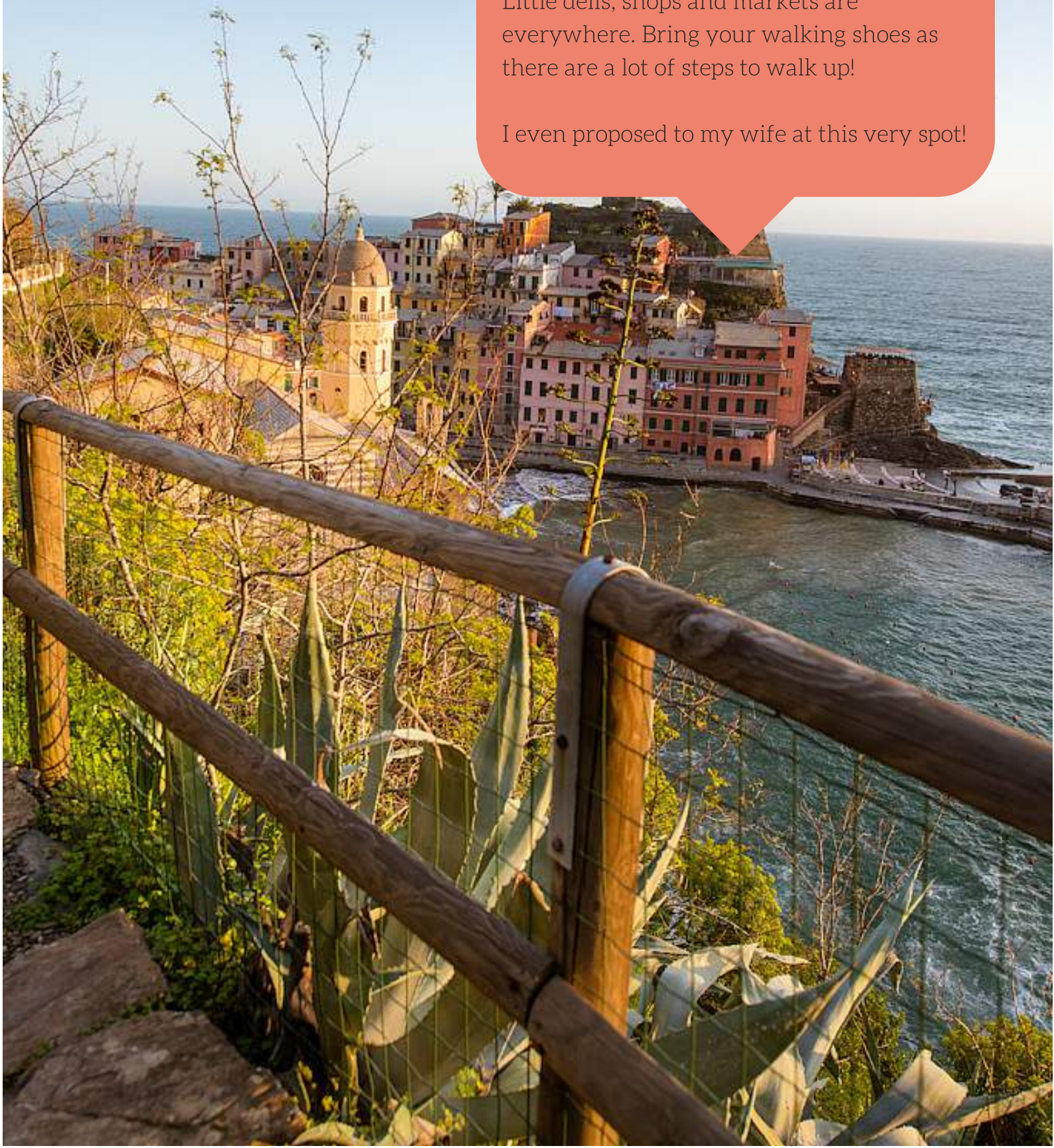
No 4

Use Istanbul as your base to see more of Turkey for an extended honeymoon.

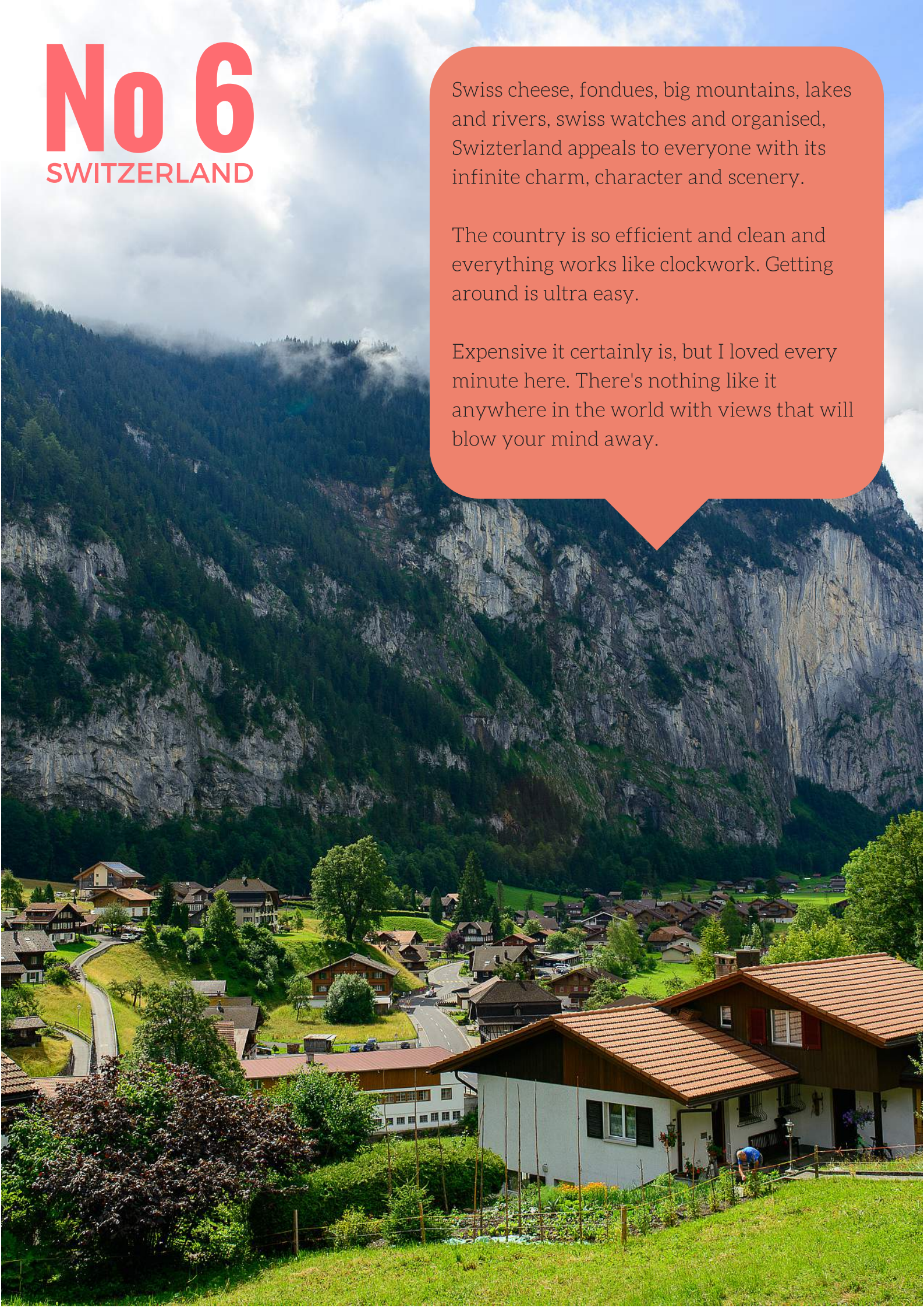
No 6

If you're looking for something different and a adventure close to home, this is it, or if you're limited in time.



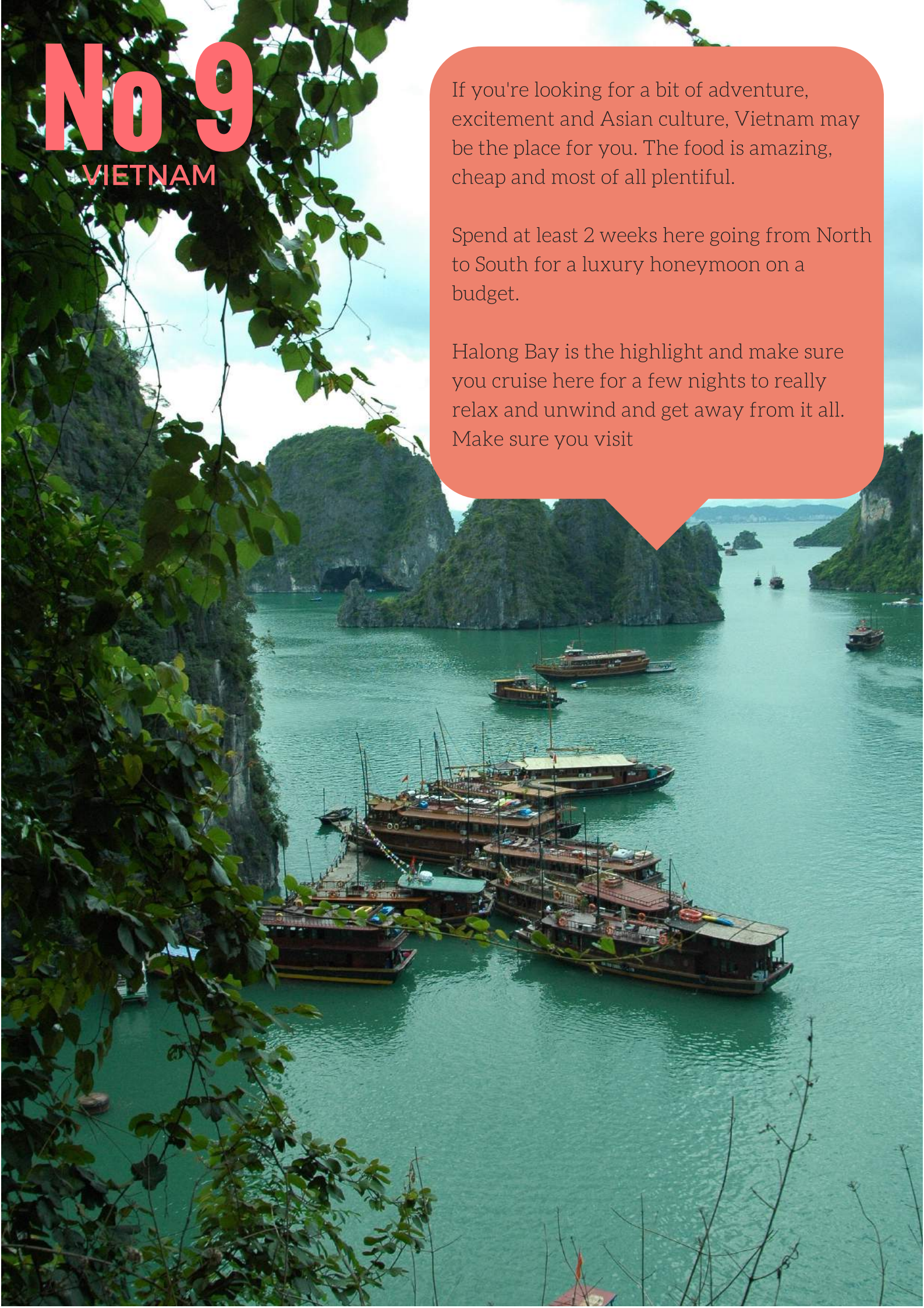
No 9

Halong Bay is the highlight and make sure you cruise here for a few nights to really relax and unwind and get away from it all. Make sure you visit



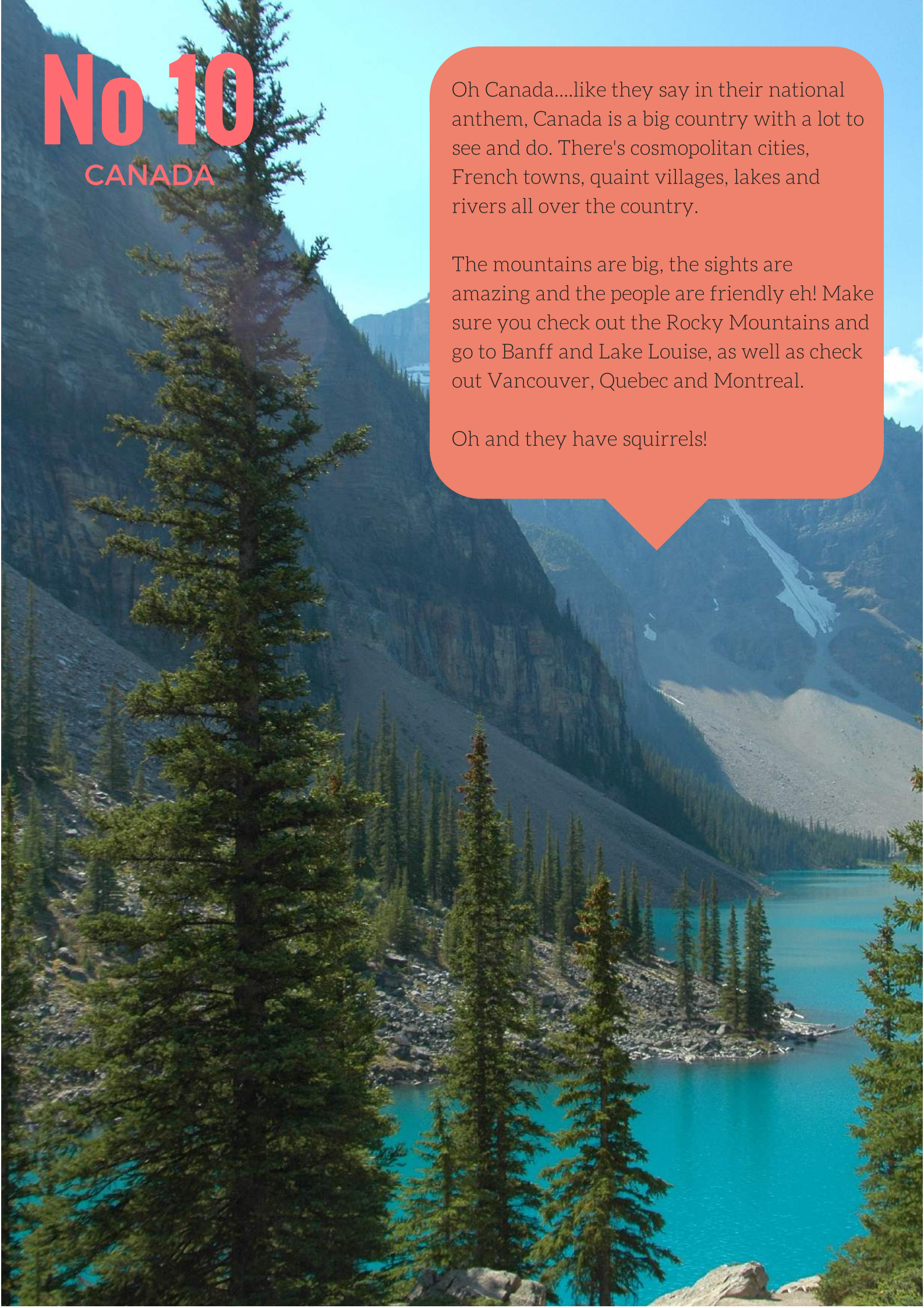
No 10

CANADA

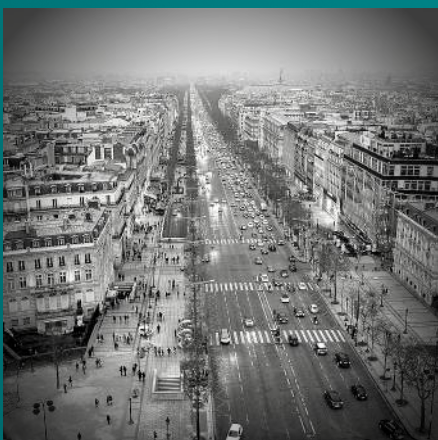
